

**SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?**

“Shall the Board of Directors of the Davenport Community School District, in the Counties of Scott and Muscatine, State of Iowa, levy a voter-approved physical plant and equipment property tax not exceeding ninety-seven cents (\$0.97) per thousand dollars of assessed valuation for a period of ten (10) years, commencing on July 1, 2009, to be placed in the Physical Plant and Equipment Levy fund and expended for the purchase and improvement of grounds; the construction of schoolhouses or buildings and opening roads to schoolhouses or buildings; the purchase of buildings and the purchase, lease, or lease-purchase of a single unit of equipment or equipment or technology exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500) in value per unit; the payment of debts contracted for the erection or construction of schoolhouses or buildings, not including interest on bonds; procuring or acquisition of library facilities; repairing, remodeling, reconstructing, improving or expanding the schoolhouses or buildings and additions to existing schoolhouses; expenditures for energy conservation; the rental of facilities under Chapter 28E; purchase of transportation equipment for transporting students; purchase of buildings or lease-purchase option agreements for school buildings; equipment purchases for recreational purposes; payments to a municipality or other entity as required by law; and all other lawful purposes?”
