Shall the Board of Directors of the North Scott Community School District in Scott County, State of Iowa, be authorized to levy annually, as determined by the Board, a voter-approved public education and recreation levy property tax not to exceed thirteen and one-half cents (13-1/2¢) per one thousand dollars (\$1,000) of the assessed valuation of the taxable property within the school district commencing with the levy for collection in the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2020, to be used to establish and maintain for children and adults public recreation places and playgrounds and necessary accommodations for the recreation places and playgrounds in the public school buildings and grounds of the district; to cooperate under chapter 28E with public agencies having the custody and management of public parks or public buildings and grounds and private agencies having custody and management of buildings or grounds open to the public, located within the school district and to provide for the supervision and instruction necessary to carry on public educational and recreational activities in the parks, buildings, and grounds located within the district all as provided in Chapter 300 of the lowa Code; and to establish a community education program for schools in the district and provide for the general supervision of the program pursuant to Chapter 276 of the lowa Code?

Shall the City of Eldridge, Iowa issue its bonds in an amount not exceeding the amount of \$7,500,000 for the purpose of aiding in the planning, undertaking, and carrying out of urban renewal projects under the authority of Iowa Code Chapter 403, and the Eldridge Unified Urban Renewal Plan, as amended, for the Eldridge Unified Urban Renewal Area, including the construction of and equipping a recreation/wellness facility, with related site improvements, generally consisting of an approximately 36,000 square foot facility, with swimming pools, gym and exercise/recreation facilities, to be located at 104 S. Third Avenue, Lot 1, Wiese's 1st Addition, to be jointly owned by the City and the North Scott Community School District, and operated by the Scott County Family Y, a 501(c)(3) organization?
